Campus Technology

As a student, you will have the ability to interact with instructors and classmates and manage your student information through four key accounts. You have a unique account for the following services:

- TitanApps—This is the official email account for UW Oshkosh students, staff, and faculty. TitanApps is also one of the primary methods of communication between you and your academic advisor. Students are required to check their UWO email account regularly, as they are responsible for the information received.
- Net ID—This account is used for Desire2Learn (D2L), library databases and campus computers.
- Desire2Learn (D2L)—This is UW Oshkosh's online learning platform, where you will access your online and hybrid classes. Here you will find course syllabi, messages from your instructor, class assignments, and discussion forums for each class.
- **TitanWeb**—This is your Student Center, which includes personal information such as grades, tuition, class schedule, STAR report, transcripts, and financial aid information.

Username and Password Keeper

TitanApps—Set up this account first to obtain your username

Your TitanApps username is created by combining:

- The first 5 letters of your last name and the first letter of your first name; and
- The last 2 digits of your ID number (except in rare cases where that name has been taken, then it is the 5th and 6th numbers from the ID number); and
- @uwosh.edu
- Example: Clash Titan, ID# 0123456, would be titanc56@uwosh.edu

The password depends on several things.

- If you had a TitanMail account, which was the University's email provider before TitanApps, but NEVER logged in, the password is your ID number.
- If you had a TitanMail account and you DID log in, the password is a random string of characters that is in your TitanMail account from UW Oshkosh Google Team. Go to TitanMail, find the email, copy the password, and follow instructions in the email.
- If you DID NOT have TitanMail created at all (new students), the password is your ID number.


^{*}Have your student ID number ready when accessing these accounts for the first time.

Logging in to TitanApps (go to www.gmail.com to log in):

- Enter your full email address as the username (e.g. titanc56@uwosh.edu). Though Google provides the email server through Gmail, your email address does not end in @gmail.com.
- You can view video tutorials for using TitanApps at www.uwosh.edu/titanapps.

NetID (**log-in for D2L**)—Set up your NetID account before logging into D2L Your username for NetID is the first part of your TitanApps username with NO @uwosh.edu. For example, Clash Titan's NetID is titanc56.

To set your password if you have never logged in to your NetID account, go to https://netid.uwosh.edu/changePassword/. Choose the first-time activation button and use your Titan ID number (no W) as your current password. See the illustration below. Once you set up this account, use this username and password to log into your classes in D2L.



Desire2Learn (D2L)

Access D2L by using the drop down box on the landing page of <u>www.uwosh.edu</u>. Use your NetID username and password to log in.



TitanWeb

Your username for TitanWeb is capital W and your student ID number. For example, Clash Titan's username is W0123456. TitanWeb has a password hint. Setting the password hint allows you to use the "Forgot Password" link on the login page to have the system email you a temporary password.

When you log in for the first time, you will use your default password. The default password is:

- The first two letters of your first name; and
- The first two letters of your last name; and
- The last four digits of your student ID number

The letters must be UPPERCASE and there are no spaces between the characters. After your initial log-in, please change your password. TitanWeb is accessed from the landing page of www.uwosh.edu the same as D2L). Tutorials for using TitanWeb can be found at www.uwosh.edu/registrar/titanweb.

Additional Information

Passwords

- You may use the same password for all three logins, but remember each is a separate account on a separate system. Changing one password does NOT change the others.
- Too many attempts with the wrong password will lock the account. That is part of security to discourage hackers, but it can affect you too.

Each account will be used for something different:

- TitanApps—email, calendar, contacts, chat, tasks, Google Drive
- NetID—D2L, student computer lab login, TitanFiles, library databases
- TitanWeb—check STAR, check grades, view tuition bill

If you need assistance with these accounts or if you forget your username or password, please call the Academic Computing Help Desk at (920) 424-3020, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m.–4:30pm. For security reasons the Help Desk cannot change a password based on an email request. If you have non-password related questions, you can email Academic Computing at acstallar. acstallar.

Registration Calendar

<u>Click here to view the current registration calendar.</u> Students can register for the next semester after their enrollment appointment, which can be found on TitanWeb. Schedule an appointment with your advisor prior to that date. These calendars show session start and end dates and last dates to add and drop classes.

Drop or Withdrawal Refund Calendar

Students who drop or withdraw a class must be aware that the percent of refund per credit diminishes as the course proceeds. Seven week, accelerated courses have a shortened window of time in which to drop the class, compared to fourteen-week classes.

Please note: Dropping and adding classes may increase your tuition cost. Courses that are dropped after the 100 percent refund period will be included in your total number of credits, and you will be charged. It is important to speak to your advisor and carefully consider the financial implications of dropping a course after the 100 percent refund period.

Obtaining your textbooks

Textbooks are typically available for purchase two weeks prior to the beginning of each semester at University Books & More, located on first floor in Reeve Memorial Union.

If you are unable to buy your books in person, you may reserve your textbooks by visiting the <u>University Books & More Website</u>. <u>Click here to view instructions on ordering textbooks</u>. You may also purchase your books from an alternate source. Just be sure to copy the exact ISBN number to get the correct edition.
